Safe Arrival

Please ensure that you call the school at 613-925-2803 or send a text message to 647-489-9642 before 9:15 am if your child will not be attending school on that day. When you contact the school, please indicate the specific reason for your child's absence. If we have not been informed of your child's absence, under the Safe Arrival Policy of UCDSB, we will make every attempt to contact you. If this proves unsuccessful, the next course of action is to make a visit to your home and contact the police to ensure that your child is safe.



School Procedures – Some Important Details

Before School Daily Screening:

Parents are required to screen their child/children each morning prior to bus or school arrival and sign/date confirmation of daily screening form ensure it is sent with their child/children each day. You can use the on-line screening tool at <https://covid-19.ontario.ca/school-screening/> or follow the screening tool sent to all families on September 7th. Any child showing COVID-19 symptoms should not come to school. Please ensure that you contact the office to advise that your child is ill.

Masks: Masks are mandatory for all students in Grades 1-6 when indoors and on school buses. Kindergarten students are strongly encouraged to wear masks. Each student learning area will have guidelines to safely store individual student masks when they are not being worn. Masks are not required when students are playing outside. Please ensure your child comes to school daily with at least 2 masks. Masks should be washed after each school day to ensure effectiveness.

School Arrival: Bus Students: At 9:20 am, bus students will unload and wait at the green pylons at the front of the school. Students will enter the school through the main entrance and will be directed by school staff to their classrooms. Students will move directly to their classes where they will be greeted by their classroom teachers/early childhood educators.

Walkers / Drop Offs: At 9:20 am, students will be welcomed through the walker gate, one family at a time and will be directed by staff to the appropriate entrance door for their class. **Please do not arrive early, as we are not able to have students on the yard before 9:20 am.** Parents are encouraged to do curbside drop-off if your child is old enough to line up independently. If you need to accompany your child to wait to enter the yard, you can do so; however, parents/guardians are not permitted inside the gated area. Please be patient, parking is limited and the drop off area could become congested at arrival and dismissal. Please consider parking farther away from the school and walking your child to the drop off zone.

Dismissal: Bus Students: At 3:30 pm, classroom teachers will begin walking students to their buses.

Walkers / Pick-ups: At 3:30 pm, classroom teachers will walk the walkers/pick-ups to the north gate where they will wait in a physically distanced line in their class cohorts. When parents arrive to collect their children, staff will call them from the waiting zone, one family at a time. Please be patient. The pick-up area may be busy, and we need to ensure that students and families are physically distanced as they await pick-up. Parents are asked to line up along the fence and wait to be greeted by the dismissal staff. We thank you in advance for your patience in the first few weeks as we work to make this an efficient process.

Allergy Safe / Scent Free School

We have several staff members and students with severe allergies at Wellington. Please ensure that you do not send snacks or lunches that contain **nuts of any kind or soy butter** to school. We are also a **scent free** environment. Please refrain from wearing scented products in the school. The safety of our staff and students is our main concern.
